Abstract

A trial was carried out in an epidemic of non-A non-B hepatitis using a single dose of human serum globulin, produced locally, for immunoprophylaxis. Anicteric hepatitis was observed in 0.8 per cent of the group which received immunoglobulin as against 2.5 per cent of control group who did not receive it.
