## **Abstract**

Acute viral hepatitis (AVH) results in only a limited number of outcomes. The patient may or may not recover from the infection and get rid of the virus (while having either a symptomatic or an asymptomatic illness). The “may not” occurs if the patient dies during the acute phase (in particular, from fulminant hepatitis) or if the patient develops a chronic infection.
